Why is Member Day a virtual conference?



COVID-19

During COVID-19, we switched to a virtual conference platform



Accessible

More libraries can attend a virtual event

More types of library staff can attend virtually

Can make the event available to ALL Illinois libraries



Higher Attendance

Registration count for Member Day since going virtual: 300-400 members

Attendee count for 2019 in-person event: ~100

How do we plan for this?

- Team-focused project planning.
- Breaking down the project into 4 sprints. Typically, each sprint lasts roughly 3 months, except the last sprint, which is only 1 month.



How the team is broken down

Project Planning – create project plan, project schedule, task breakdown, team building, budget analysis

Marketing/Communications – graphics, emails, newsletter communication, event website development

Programming – finding speakers, event schedule development, speaker dry runs for Zoom

Sponsorships – creation of sponsorship levels, networking with vendors and sponsors/partners

Game Development – Trivia, prizes and prize drawing, and other activities as decided

Tech – purchasing Pheedloop, setting up sessions, monitoring event support chat

1	anonymous	Honestly everything. Minor hiccups are expected.
2	anonymous	I liked Loop. I liked the monthly meetings and some of the exercises (like the bad idea brainstorm). I felt my responsibilities and deadlines were clear.








How do we collaborate?

Loop is a collaborative software that integrates with other Microsoft software in real-time.






Why we do an attendee survey.

- How will we divide the tasks of setting up networking opportunities?




Overall, how would you rate this virtual event?
