## Membership Considerations

April, 2018

After the certification process ended on March 31, 2018. One library is recommended for suspension. That library is the Morthland College Library.

In the certification process, it was stated that the library did not meet the staffing requirement and was not compliant with the ILLINET Interlibrary Loan Code. It appears that the library has had no circulation through this academic year. There have been two follow-up messages sent to the college regarding this process and they are aware of the pending suspension. Morthland College is recommended for suspension from membership in the Illinois Heartland Library System.

Two school District have made formal application for system membership. They are the East St. Louis School District #189 and Greenview CUSD #200

Greenview School District is a K-12 District in Menard County Illinois. A site visit was done in November 2017 to assess the school's eligibility for membership. An application for membership has been submitted and it is recommended for full membership.

The East St. Louis School District #189 is a K-12 District in St. Clair County comprised of a high school, 2 middle schools and several elementary schools. A site visit was done in February, 2017 with follow-up done in the fall of 2017. An application for membership has been submitted and the district is recommended for full membership.
